

## BFG Master Class with Macy Sullivan of The Juilliard School Friday July 23<sup>th</sup> & Saturday July 24<sup>th</sup>

Macy Sullivan is a rising junior at The Juilliard School, where she studies ballet, modern, partnering, choreography, and dance composition. Her classical training began at The School of Oregon Ballet Theatre, under the direction of Damara Bennett. During her six years, she rose through the levels, dancing her final year on merit scholarship in the Pre-Professional Division. During this time, she trained and performed with Oregon Ballet Theatre's professional company, under the artistic direction of Christopher Stowell. As an SOBT student, Sullivan has had the opportunity to perform roles in George Balanchine's Serenade and Raymonda, Christopher Smuin's "Street Dancers" from Romeo and Juliet, Christopher Stowell's Peter and the Wolf, and August Bournonville's Napoli. She has danced several roles with the OBT company in George Balanchine's The Nutcracker, as well as the role of Little Red Riding Hood in Christopher Stowell's The Sleeping Beauty. For several years, OBT entrusted her to teach and rehearse Balanchine's "Polichinelles" from The Nutcracker. SOBT hosted her as a repertory teacher for the past two years during its Summer Intensive.

Prior to attending SOBT, Sullivan studied ballet, tap, jazz, and lyrical with Karen Cannon at DanceWorks in Vancouver, Washington. Her love was tap, and in 2003, she represented the United States at the World Tap Dance Championships in Ljubljana, Slovenia, adjudicated as the first-place champion.

Level III – Advanced Ballet (Senior) Saturday 9:00-11:00/10:30-11:00 Question &

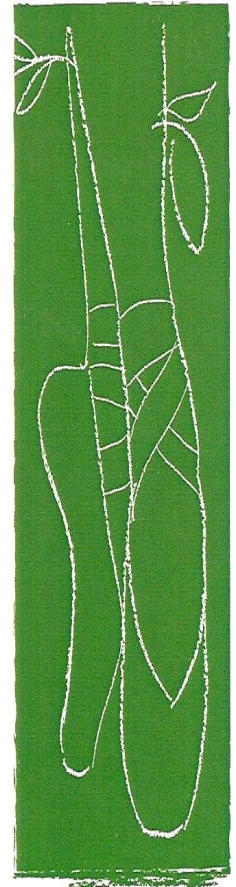
